<b>DEPARTMENTAL SUPPORT/PROGRAM COSTS FOR DOCTORAL STUDENTS</b>
<p>For a student entering our graduate program with a bachelor's degree, departmental support begins at a minimum of \$13,000. For a student entering our program with a master's degree in psychology (or a closely related field), departmental support begins at a minimum of \$13,250. This support is offered in the form of a nine-month academic year appointment as a .42 full time equivalent (FTE)</p>

graduate teaching/research fellow (GTF). Pending satisfactory first-year performance, we also offer summer support in the form of a summer session GTF appointment at .20 FTE or more, generating additional earnings of \$2,060 or more.

GTFs with an appointment equal to or greater than .20 FTE receive a tuition waiver that exempts them from payment of the instruction fee portion of tuition on the first 16 credit hours per term. During the 2008-09 academic year, the tuition waiver is valued at \$3,510 per term for residents and \$5,184 per term for non-residents. GTFs are assessed non-instructional fees set by the Oregon University System at \$538 per term for 2008-09, of which the university pays \$388; the student is responsible for the balance of \$150 as stipulated in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the University of Oregon and the Graduate Teaching Fellows Federation. The one-time \$250 matriculation fee normally required of new students is waived for each new student who is a GTF in their first term at the university.

GTFs are also eligible to receive health insurance benefits for themselves at no cost, and at a subsidized rate for family members. During the 2008-09 academic year, the value of the health insurance benefit for a single GTF is approximately \$818 per term.

Support after the first year is contingent on a student's satisfactory progress in the program and the availability of funds. The Department places a high priority on supporting our graduate students and has an excellent record of doing so. In fact, nearly all students in the last two decades have received a full four years of support.
